Subject : 38th NTPC Sub-Junior (Boys & Girls) National (Recurve, Compound & Indian Round) Archery Championship at Amravati, Maharashtra from 21st to 30th November, 2021.

Dear Sir/Madam

I am directed by Hony. Secretary General, AAI to inform you that the 38th NTPC Sub-Junior (Boys & Girls) National (Recurve, Compound and Indian Round) Archery Championship will be held at Amravati, Maharashtra from 21st to 30th November, 2021 (inclusive of both arrival and departure days) under the aegis of Maharashtra Archery Association.

All the stakeholders are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for your own convenience and to ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above competitions.

I) Competition fixture, Arrival/Departure of Teams

Sub-Junior National will be conducted in three phases as per below mentioned programme:-

Event	Arrival	Competition	Departure
Recurve (B & G)	21 st Nov, 2021	22 nd & 23 rd Nov, 2021	23 rd Nov. (even)/24 th Nov. (before noon)
Compound (B & G)	24 th Nov, 2021	25 th & 26 th Nov, 2021	26 th Nov. (even)/27 th Nov. (before noon)
Indian Round (B & G)	27 th Nov, 2021	28 th & 29 th Nov, 2021	29 th Nov. (even)/30 th Nov. (before noon)

All participating teams are requested to follow the arrival and departure schedule strictly in order to avoid any inconvenience to participants of the subsequent event. Teams reaching Amravati before arrival day or leaving from Amravati after departure day are requested to make their own arrangements.

II) Eligibility

i) **Age** - All participants must fulfill the age rules of Archery Association of India according to which an athlete may participate in a Sub-Junior National when the competition takes place up to and in the year of his/her 17th birthday. It means anyone born on **1st January, 2004** or later is eligible to participate in the Sub-Junior National Championship.

- ii) **Affiliation through AAI Portal** - All the eligible/selected participants including Archers, Coaches, Team Officials & Technical Officials for the National Championship are required to be affiliated on the 'Online Affiliation Online Portal' of the AAI through the AAI website (www.indianarchery.info). The entry of any unaffiliated person would not be entertained.
- iii) **Affiliation Card** - Carrying coloured 'Affiliation Card' (in physical form) to be generated after getting successful affiliation is a mandatory requirement for taking part in the event.
- iv) **Entry** - Each participating member unit is eligible to field one team of maximum four men and one team of maximum four women archers in each of the category (Recurve, Compound & Indian Round) in National Championship. No individual or additional entry is allowed in the National Championship. Maximum one manager, one male coach and one female coach are allowed with the team.

III) Entry Procedure, Deadlines, Penalty

- i) Entry of participating State Association/Associate Members for Sub-Junior National Championships should reach on or before **13th November, 2021** at archeryselectionindia@gmail.com in prescribed format as Annexure 'A'.
- ii) Entries received after the deadline, but by **17th November, 2021** will lead to a Penalty Fee of ₹ 2,000/- per member per category. After **17th November, 2021** no entry would be entertained by AAI for the Sub-Junior National Championship. Member Associations / Units who are late entrants will have to intimate AAI in writing, accepting the relevant penalty clause, in order for their teams / members entry to be considered. The Late Entry Penalty Fee can be paid either through RTGS in AAI bank account before the event or upon arrival at the competition venue to the representative of AAI. Any member Association / Unit that has Penalty Fee outstanding will need to have paid the same in full before being eligible to participate.

IV) Accommodation and Food

- i) Free boarding and lodging will be provided to all the participants of the member State Associations/ Associate Members as specified above in clause II & sub-clause iv.
- ii) The LOC will not be responsible for additional Coaches, Manager and Parents etc.

V) Safety and Health Measures

The SOP (Standard Operating Procedure) and guidelines issued by Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and by the State Government for organizing sports events/social gathering under COVID-19 environment shall be strictly and scrupulously followed. The following general health measures are to be observed by all the athletes and officials, however LOC will convey the local SOP along with the invitation letter/tournament brochure.

- Use of face covers/face masks at all times except while shooting the arrows.
- Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed by participants. This involves the strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/ handkerchief/ flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- Self-monitoring of health by participants and reporting any illness at the earliest to the Competition Director/DOS.
- Use of alcohol-based personal hand sanitizers at all times during competition, travel and stay.
- Sharing of personal equipment and articles such as soap, towel, any other utility may be avoided by all.
- Spitting shall be strictly prohibited in field of play and practice areas.
- Participants, while not in field of play, shall practice frequent hand washing with soap.
- Installation & use of 'Aarogya Setu App' on the mobile phones shall be advised to all.
- No Entry of outsider/stranger inside competition venue except eligible participants.
- Participants will be restricted to move in the field before or after the event.

VI) Reception

All the participating teams (in group) will be received from Railway Station/Bus Terminal, if arrival intimation is received by the LOC well in time.

VII) Flag

Flag of each participating member State Associations/Associate Members will be hoisted in the competition field and one will be required for March Past. Therefore, all teams are required to carry two sets of standard size flags (6 ft X 4 ft) while leaving their destinations for Amravati.

VIII) Railway Concession Certificate

The Railway Ministry has suspended fare concessions across 38 categories, which include sportspersons. It is understood that the move was aimed at discouraging train journey for some time to contain the spread of coronavirus. Taking cognizance of the difficulties of sportspersons, Hon'ble Minister of Sports and Indian Olympic Association have taken up the matter separately with the Ministry of Railways to restore the concession in fares which is pending with the Railway Ministry. AAI will immediately post three Railway Concession Forms once the concession is restored.
