
It is observed that some Campers including Archers and Coaches do not attend the National Camp. A few join the Camp late and a number of Campers take leave without prior intimation/permission.

Archery Association of India and Sports Authority of India have taken a very serious view on the irregular attendance and casual attitude of some Campers with respect to the National Coaching Camps.

All concerned State Associations/Units and Campers may please note the following for strict compliance:-

- 1) Archery Association of India will announce from time to time the date and venue for National Camps and the list of Campers on the basis of the National Ranking Archery Tournaments.
- 2) Selected Archers, Coaches and Support Staff should join the Camp on the date of reporting as per the circular of Archery Association of India.
- 3) If an Archer is unable to join the Camp or would join late, he or she should give AAI the reason, in writing with documentary justification, within three (3) days of announcement of list of Campers. If no information is received from an absentee, the next ranked Archer based on the NRAT will replace him/her in the Camp. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject the reasons given by the Archer.
- 4) It is obligatory for an Archer selected for the Indian team for International competitions other than Asian Games to join the Camp at least 15 days prior to departure for International Competitions, failing which the Archer ranked next to those in the team, will replace the erring Archer.
- 5) In the case of Asian Games, it is obligatory for all selected Archers to attend the Camp from the date of reporting, failing which the Archer ranked next to those selected for the Camp will replace the erring Archer.
- 6) If a Coach /Support Staff is unable to join the Camp or would join late, he or she should give AAI the reason, in writing with documentary justification, within three (3) days of announcement of list of Campers. If no information is received from an absentee, the AAI will replace him/her in the Camp. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject the reasons given by the Coach/Support Staff.
- 7) A Coach will be designated at the Camp to communicate to AAI and SAI about Campers' attendance, with details of absence, late joining, leave with/without intimation and a report to the effect would be sent to the AAI and SAI every week.
- 8) An AAI official will be designated to monitor the National Coaching Camp.

Archery Association of India will not hesitate to take stringent action against indiscipline on the part of any Archer, Coach or Support Staff.
